



## Positive Boundaries follow on support

Positive Boundaries (previously called TeenBoundaries) works to prevent sexual bullying, peer on peer sexual exploitation and promotes positive gender relationships. Work on the issues that we address is best if it is ongoing, consistent and sensitive to the fact that these matters are inescapable for young people.



We have devised follow-up workshops and services for schools that contain guidance and suggestions for teachers about running further sessions, with lesson-plans and materials that encourage discussions to deepen the understanding and confidence Positive Boundaries generates.
