Job Title: Web Developer (C#, MVC)

Our dynamic environment is fast paced, using Agile and self-organizing principles for our teams to deliver the highest quality new products.

Purpose of Job

The Web Developer (C#, MVC) works as part of a self-organising Scrum team that is responsible for building a front-end and back-end affiliate management product.

The front-end provides a platform for affiliates to sign up, customise their traffic and view their statistics on a daily basis.

The back-end provides affiliate managers/administrators a platform for managing accounts, permissions, reports, marketing tools, etc.

The product has been developed using agile principles and technologies like VS2013 & MVC 4, EF 6, Signal R and various JavaScript frameworks and libraries. We use TDD and tools like ReSharper, StyleCop and DotCover.

Key Responsibilities & Accountabilities

The Web Developer (C#, MVC) position will involve the following areas of responsibility:

- Designing technical solutions to meet business requirements
- Developing new features and maintaining existing ones
- Participating in scrum rituals like stand-ups, planning sessions, demos and retrospectives
- Participation in team activities such as collaborative development and code reviews
